



TERMS OF REFERENCE

REMOVAL, REFRAMING, SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF GLASS DOOR AND GLASS WINDOW OF OLD CLAIM'S BOARD ROOM AT THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

I. BACKGROUND

The Commission on Human Rights (Commission) is an independent National Human Rights Institution (NHRI) created under the 1987 Philippine Constitution, established on 05 May 1987 by virtue of Executive Order N o. 163. The Commission is mandated to conduct investigations on human rights violations against marginalized and vulnerable sectors of the society, involving civil and political rights.

The Commission is currently managing to improve and renovate its existing facilities by providing an adequate, conducive, and more safety-working environment for CHR employees, clients, and visitors. For this purpose, it is need of a suitable supplier/contractor that can supply, deliver, and install the glass door and windows.

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this procurement project is to obtain the services of legitimate, reputable and experienced supplier/contractor that can supply, deliver, and install glass door and window of Old Claims Boardroom at CHR PARDEC Building as set below in Scope of Services and Technical Specification/Bill of Quantities.


III. DESCRIPTION AND SCOPE OF SERVICES


The services shall include the following:

- 1. Site inspection and verifying dimensions on actual
- 2. Removal existing windows, window frames and iron grills. (see technical specification for dimension)
- 3. Check and verify the drawings / design provided by the CHR Consultant before any installation to be done.
- 4. Installation of frames of the windows and doors
- 5. Installation of glass for the door and exterior glazing.
- 6. Punch listing.





V. PROJECT DURATION

Supply, delivery and installation must be completed within Twenty-Five (25) calendar days from receipt of Notice of Proceed (NTP), provided the place/area for installation is clear from any obstruction.

VI. REQUIREMENTS

A. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Bidder must have the necessary experience and expertise in the above-mentioned project or similar project by submitting proofs of the following as part of the technical proposal:

- 1. Business Permit/Licenses of the Bidder;
- 2. Engaged in the same business for at least two (2) years;
- 3. No record of at least 3 months overdue project delivery at the CHR (those without request for extension);
- 4. Bidder's office should be located within Mega Manila.

B. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Interested suppliers are required to submit their valid and current Mayor's permit, and PhilGeps Registration Number, upon submission of Quotation/Proposal. PhilGeps Membership may be submitted in lieu of the Mayor's/ Business Permit and the PhilGeps Registration Number.

C. FINANCIAL OFFER

1. The prospective supplier must quote the best offer of the subject item. The financial offer shall be tax inclusive and shall be used as basis for the evaluation and calculation of the quotation.

VII. TERMS AND CONDITION

- A. The Purchase Order (P.O.) and Contract shall be accepted by the supplier prior to the delivery of goods/services.
- B. Non-availability of goods in bill of quantities shall be made known to the Procuring Entity/End-User prior to the implementation of the project.
- C. The Commission shall have the right to reject the goods and/or cancel the P.O./Contract and request for improvements/replacement if they are found to be non-compliant with the specifications. Further, the Commission shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm if the latter are in conformity with the technical specifications.
- D. Supplier may submit a request for extension of delivery within the period specified in the contract for the approval of the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE).
- E. Failure to deliver goods as specified in the contract or within the extension period shall authorize the Commission to liquidated damages of at least equal to one-tenth of

one percent (1%) of the cost of unperformed portion for everyday of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by the procuring entity concerned.

The Commission may rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

- F. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the bidder or his/her duly authorized representative.
- G. Any modifications in the contract implementation must be approved by the Commission.
- H. No subcontracting shall be allowed for the entire project.
- I. Deliveries and Installation must be completed in one batch.
- J. The CHR thru Bids & Awards Committee (BAC) will base its governing final decision on the bidder's design, befitting its functionality, warranty and aftersales, project management capability, furniture customization capacity, space maximization, workflow efficiency and aesthetics that will best serve the end-user's requirement.

VIII. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment shall be made through Land Bank's LDDAP-ADA/BANK Transfer facility, processed within twenty (20) calendar days upon final acceptance of goods as described in the Scope of Work and Technical Specifications and upon approval of Inspection and Acceptance (IAR)/Acceptance and Completion Report. Bank Transfer fee shall be charged against the creditor's account for other Banking Institution.

IX. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT (ABC):

Two Hundred Thousand Pesos - Php 200,000.00

X. WARRANTY AND COVERAGE

Warranty – At least three (3) months warranty on equipment, parts and services from the date of the Final Acceptance and completion of the delivery of goods.

XI. EXECUTION AND PRE-TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT

- 1. This Terms of Reference (TOR) shall form an integral part of the Contract, which shall be executed by and between the Commission as the Procuring Entity and the Supplier upon issuance of the Notice of Award (NOA).
- 2. The Contract and this TOR shall be implemented in accordance with the terms and conditions herein stipulated. Failure on the part of the Supplier to comply with any of the provisions of the Contract and this TOR shall warrant its pre-termination. The Commission shall inform the Supplier within ten (10) calendar days prior to the effectivity of the termination.

3. In case of pre-termination, the Supplier shall be liable to pay an additional liquidated damages equivalent to five percent (5%) of the Contract Price, in accordance with the Government Accounting Manual (GAM), and the performance security shall be forfeited. The Supplier shall further be blacklisted or disqualified from participating in any other project.

XII. MODE OF PROCUREMENT

TERMS OF REFERENCE

SUPPLY OF LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRANSACTION WINDOWS FOR THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

I. BACKGROUND

The Commission on Human Rights (Commission) is an independent National Human Rights Institution (NHRI) created under the 1987 Philippine Constitution, established on 05 May 1987 by virtue of Executive Order N o. 163. The Commission is mandated to conduct investigations on human rights violations against marginalized and vulnerable sectors of the society, involving civil and political rights.

Inclusive of this is the installation of new transaction window/s for Commissions' offices (IAD, FMO, SPAD, HRPAO, PMO and COA).

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this contract is to obtain the services of a qualified contractor / supplier who can install transaction window/s on the abovementioned offices to prevent direct intrusion of people into the office as set below in the Scope of Work and Technical Specifications/Bill of Quantities.

III. DESCRIPTION AND SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Services shall involve the following activities:

- 1.Removal of the existing panel (1.43m H x 57cm W)
- 2.Installation of new framing (1.43m H x 57cm W)
- 3.Cutting of the existing glass into 46.5cm H x 57cm W
- 4.Installation of the cut glass panel into new framing
- 5.Installation of the new vertical sliding glass

X. WARRANTY AND COVERAGE

XI. EXECUTION AND PRE-TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT
