RESOLUTION NO. 09-148 Series of 2020

**RECOMMENDING A FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF THE
SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF OFFICE EQUIPMENT (QR / BAR CODE SCANNER /
PRINTER & BIOMETRIC FINGER SCANNER) PURSUANT TO SECTION 35.1(c) OF
THE UPDATED 2016 REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR)
OF REPUBLIC ACT (RA) 9184**

WHEREAS, the Commission on Human Rights (CHR), through the Planning and Management Office – Management Information Systems Division (PMO-MISD), intends to procure Supply and Delivery of Office Equipment (QR/Bar Code Scanner/Printer & Biometric Finger Scanner) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Fifty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php55,000.00);

WHEREAS, said procurement project shall be sourced from the 2020 budget of CHR pursuant to the CHR Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for CY 2020;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods and Services (BAC-GS) determined the mode of procurement as Negotiated Procurement through Small Value Procurement under Section 53.9 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Republic Act (RA) No. 9184;

WHEREAS, the BAC-GS, through the Secretariat, published the Request for Quotation (RFQ) in the PhilGEPS and CHR websites and simultaneously sent out to four (4) prospective bidders of known qualifications, namely: 1] Business Machines; 2] Asianic Distributors, Inc.; 3] Barcotech Philippines, Inc. and 4] American Technologies, Inc.;

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids, the BAC-GS found the bid submission of Barcotech Philippines, Inc.. In response to the publication in the PhilGEPS and CHR websites, Afield Consulting Inc. also submitted its bid proposal on September 17, 2020 / 4:09pm which is beyond the scheduled deadline on September 10, 2020 / 10:00am, hence disqualified, pursuant to Section 25.6 of 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 *“Bids, including the eligibility requirements under Section 23.1 of this IRR, submitted after the deadline shall not be accepted by the BAC. The BAC shall record in the minutes of bid submission and opening, the bidder’s name, its representative and time the late bid was submitted”*.

WHEREAS, the evaluation of bid proposal from Barcotech Philippines, Inc. conducted by the end-user revealed that it has failed to comply with some of the requirements, to wit:

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the BAC-GS recommends failure of bidding pursuant to Section 35.1 (c) of the Updated 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 which provides that, *“The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when – All bids fail to comply with the bid requirements or fail post-qualification, or, in the case of Consulting Services, there is no successful negotiation”*;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC-GS hereby resolves as it hereby resolved to **DECLARE A FAILURE OF BIDDING** pursuant to Section 35.1 (c) of the Updated 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No.9184 which provides that *“The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when – All bids fail to comply with all the bid requirements of fail post-qualification, or, in the case of Consulting Services, there is no successful negotiation”*; and **RECOMMEND THE RE-BIDDING** of the subject procurement project pursuant to Section 35.3 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184.
